Bulk Item Pick Up

If you have bulk trash items that need to be picked up, you can call the City of Columbus at **3-1-1** and arrange for pick up.

There are specific guidelines that must be followed.

Do not put items outside until the



night before your scheduled pick up.

If items are left outside for more than 24 hours, we will have them removed by a

private company.

You will be assessed a fine of \$150.00 to cover the cost.

Parking Permit Update


The parking permits have worked very well

over the past six months. Thank you for your help in making the system work.

Few reminders:

- Permits are required, except in authorized spots, every day from 10 PM to 6 AM. No notice is needed to have the vehicle towed.
- If you park behind another person's garage without permission, the owner has the right to have your vehicle towed immediately.

Is Your Garage Door Closed?



Please remember that garage doors must be closed at all times. If you leave or go inside your condo, the garage door should be put down. Even if you are going to be back in "a few", please still follow this association rule.

If people continue to ignore this rule, the Board will need to start implementing fines.

Don't Forget about Your Trash Cans?

Trash cans and recycling bins can only be put out the evening before pick up and then must be returned to the garage by midnight of the "pick up" day. Below is the schedule for pick up.

The City of Columbus will **only pick up items in the trash cans**. If you have any items that do not fit into the trash cans, please call 311 to arrange a bulk pick up.




Assessment Deadline
